In 1788, Beauvais employed 120 workmen in manufacturing carpets of all sorts under the direction of Monsieur Demenou, who retired from the concern in 1792. In 1802, Monsieur de Berderbusch, the prefect of the department, re-established the business, and carried it to a high degree of perfection; but at this moment the number of workmen employed does not exceed 40.
