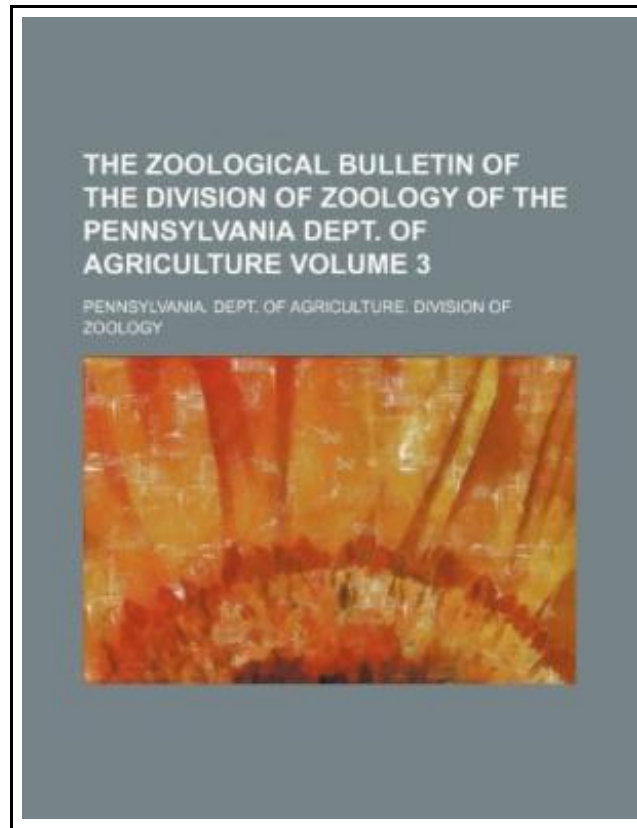

Consequently, in this great order there are species with diverse habits, varying from aquatic and feeding under water, (e. g., the Dipper or Water Ouzel of Western N. A.) to purely aerial and feeding only while flying (the Swallows), or feeding only on the ground (Meadow Lark, Horned Lark, and some Sparrows), or living wholly in the tree tops (Warblers), or on the trunks and larger branches of trees (Creepers and Nuthatches), or living only in the wildest portions of our country (the Raven), to species that seem to thrive best in the very shadow of the abode of man (English Sparrow, House Wren, Robin). In kind of food sought the Passerine Birds vary from those that are almost purely insectivorous (Flycatchers. Warblers, Chickadees, etc.), or carnivorous and competing with the smaller hawks and owls (e. g. the Butcher Birds), or wholly seed-eaters (Grosbeaks and some Sparrows), or both insectivorous and seed-eaters (Blackbirds, Meadow Lark, some sparrows), or insectivorous and fruit-eaters--taking naturally only native or wild fruits (Cedar Birds, Thrushes, etc.), to such as are omnivorous, even performing service as scavengers (Crow and Raven). Thus in kind of food and places of feeding, the Birds of this Order compete with such widely different Birds as the Gulls, Ducks and Geese, Shore Birds. Quail, Grouse, Doves, Hawks, Owls, Vultures, Cuckoos Woodpeckers Night-Hawks and Chimney Swifts. No other Order shows such a wide range of haunts, habits, and varied structures, and consequently none is of such great interest...
